

CONFIRMATION OF DEATH PROCEDURE: CLINICAL SIGNS

Observations & examination over a minimum of 5 minutes

+ Absence of carotid pulse over one minute confirmed

AND

+ Absence of heart sounds over one minute confirmed

AND

+ Absence of respiratory sounds /effort over one minute confirmed

AND

+ No response to painful stimuli (e.g. trapezius squeeze)

AND

+ Fixed dilated pupils (unresponsive to bright light)
