

Understanding the Roles of Professionals Involved Following a Sudden or Unexplained Death



NHS SCOTLAND

Provides a range of services:

- Contact with emergency services.
- Ongoing care and support via General Practitioner services.

POLICE SCOTLAND

- Uniformed police will deliver the news of a death.
- The Police Family Liaison Service formulates a relationship between Police Scotland and a family who are bereaved to facilitate further investigation. They will also assist with any media interest.

SCOTTISH AMBULANCE SERVICE

Provides a frontline emergency service, with the main aim being to preserve life.

COPFS

- · Carries out further inquiry and recovers evidence.
- Legally responsible for the body and may instruct a post mortem examination.
- May also instruct a fatal accident inquiry or criminal proceedings.
