# INTRODUCTION

Letters of Hope is a registered charity whose mission is to bring hope to the bereaved in times of despair. We design and deliver inclusive bereavement care packages. Recognising that bereavement is a multifaceted and deeply personal experience, we provide tangible comfort, practical support and emotional connection through thoughtfully curated care packages.



## METHODS: CO-DESIGN APPROACH

Our approach is grounded in compassion and inclusivity. Through collaboration with bereaved individuals, community members and healthcare professionals our care packages are co-designed to reflect a broad spectrum of experiences and preferences. Our care packages are inclusive through:

#### CULTURE

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Key components of the care packages include soothing items such as comforting socks, eye masks, teas, nourishing snacks, memory aids like journals and photo frames and sensory-friendly products that support emotional wellbeing. Child-focused kits incorporate therapeutic play materials and storytelling resources to help young people navigate grief.

### RESULTS

Qualitative feedback from recipients report emotional upliftment upon receiving care packages. Feedback is also gathered to continually refine packages to meet diverse recipient needs. This approach ensures a balance between inclusion and practical delivery within charitable bereavement care.

# CONCLUSION

This work demonstrates that care packages honouring cultural traditions, age-specific needs and different bereavement types can be powerful healing tools. Letters of Hope's approach shows that bereavement support which recognises diversity can help those grieving feel seen and supported.

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
